Enhanced welfare facilities

The town government has been trying to enhance the welfare system so that everyone can live in peace and safety. Starting with the opening of "Kunneppu Seijuen", in April 1990 "Honami", "Haruru", and "Mori no Kaze" were opened to make the town more people friendly.

Retirement home "Kunneppu Seijuen"



The very first welfare facility in Kunneppu. There is a retirement home, short stay service, and day service.

Building community through individual development.


Kindergarten "Wakuwakuen"

Opened in April 2016, it has capacity for 200 children under the age of 1 to pre-primary school. They offer both care and education. Larch from Kunneppu and Japanese cypress from its sister town Tsuno are used in the building, and by taking advantage of natural energy the atmosphere is really warm.

Childcare fee is FREE (for children 3-years-old or older)

The fee is decided based on the income-based tax amount. For tax exempt families and for families with an income-based tax amount below ¥97,000, childcare is free.

■ Childcare fee for children 2-years-old and younger (per month)

For those with:

Childcare certification (until 16:30): ¥25,740-¥47,070 Childcare certification (until 18:30): ¥28,600-¥52,300

School lunch fee (per month)

Not charged for 2-year-old and younger children

Regardless of the the income-based tax amount, the fee will be the following. For those with:

Educational certification (until 13:00): ¥4,200

Educational certification + Additional childcare (until 16:30): ¥5,800 Childcare certification(both until 16:30 and until 18:30): ¥5,800 (special case as described)

If there are two or more children enrolled in the kindergarten. the childcare fee and the lunch fee could be exempted based on the application.



New potato chips were released!




Potato chips made from potatoes called "Snow March" which were harvested in Kitami district were released nationwide. "Snow March" was named after the season
